The period of the examined documents in Hungary

1961. Decision of the hungarian socialist party about the elimination of settlements do not comply with social requirements – elimination started, available documents

After the political system changing: there are significant differences in approach

Before: central intention, central method by the exclusion of affected communities

After: supported by the state and the EU - under the application system involved roma NGOs, the affected families and local governments in the solution

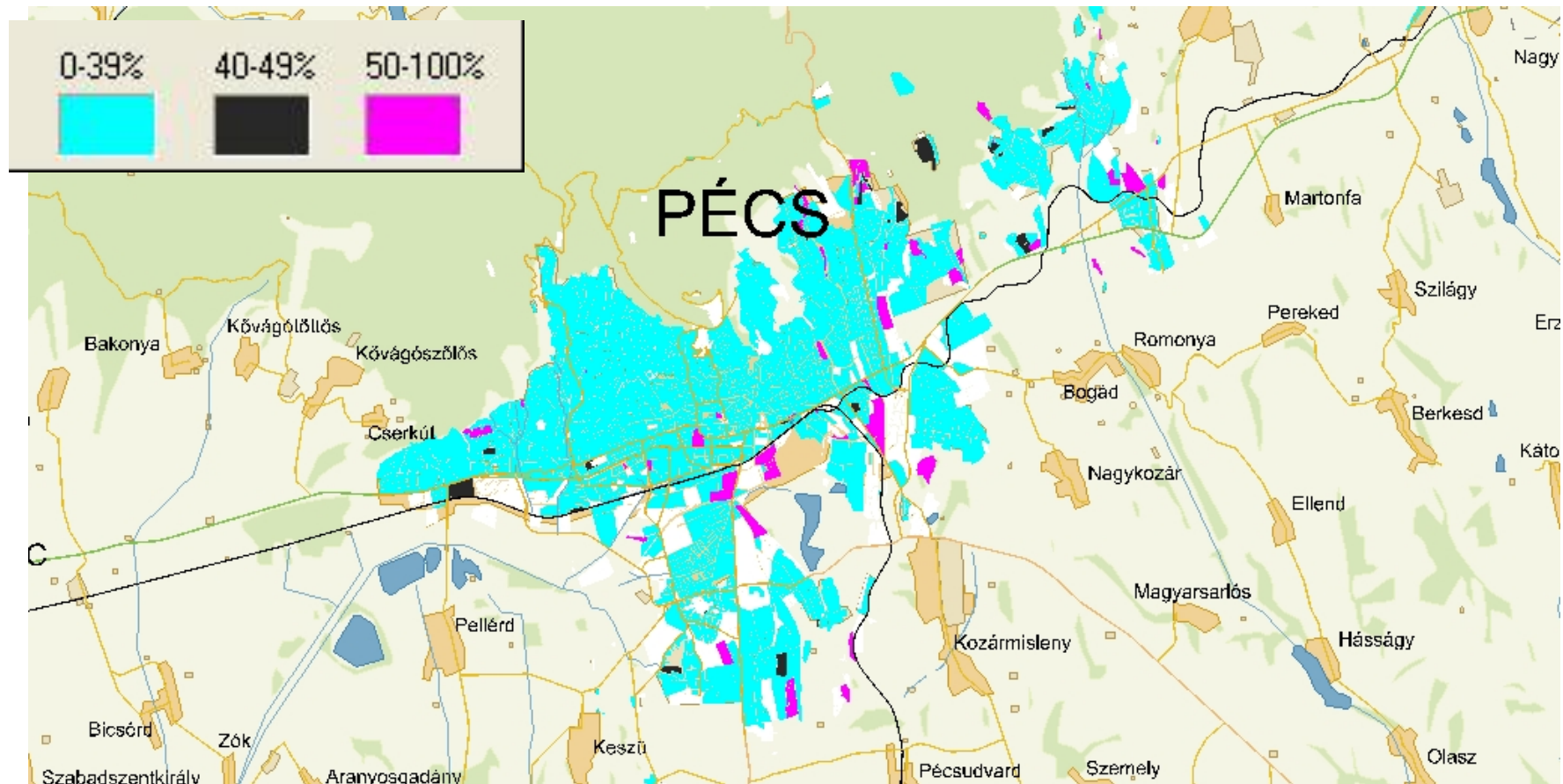

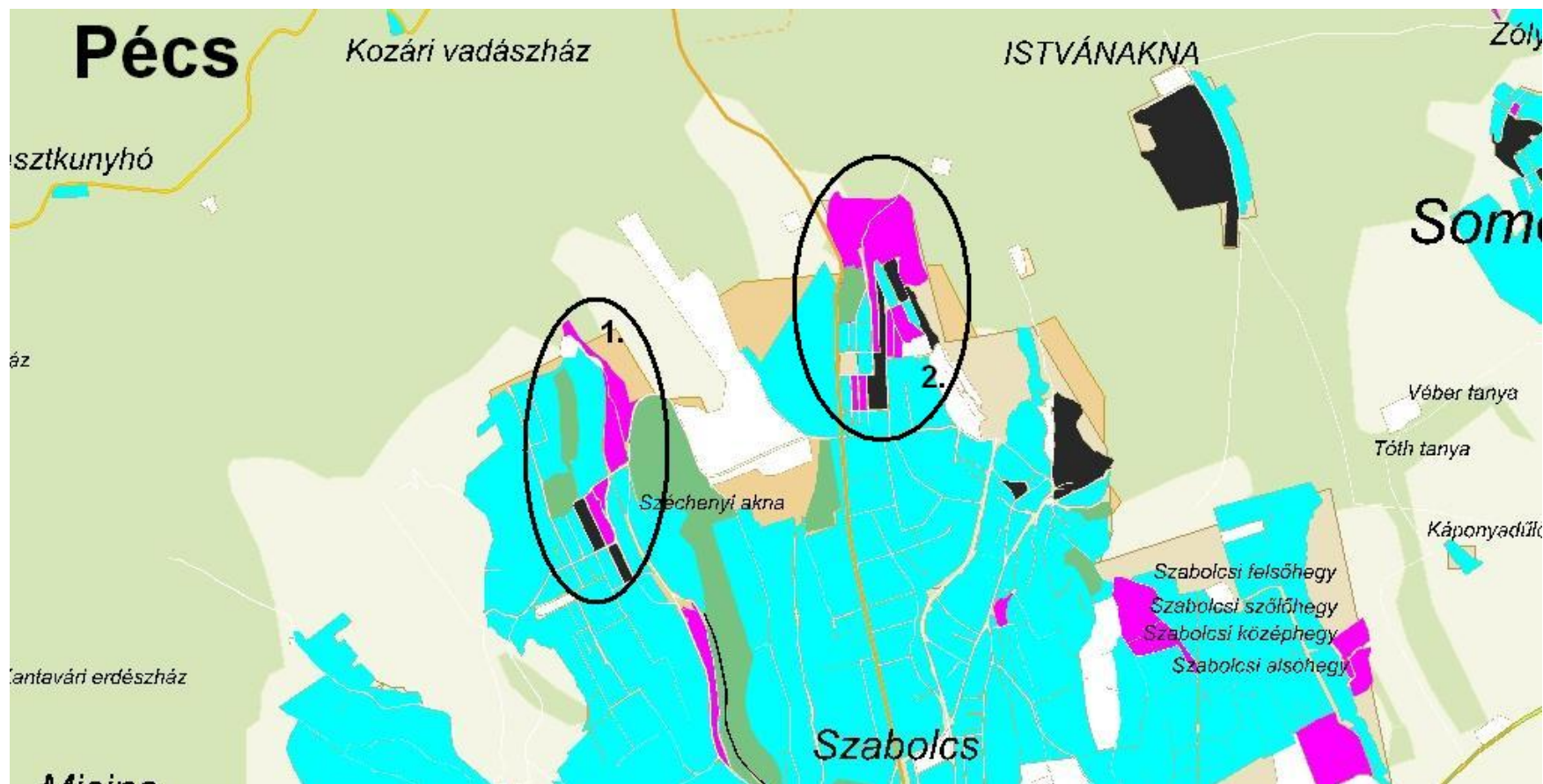

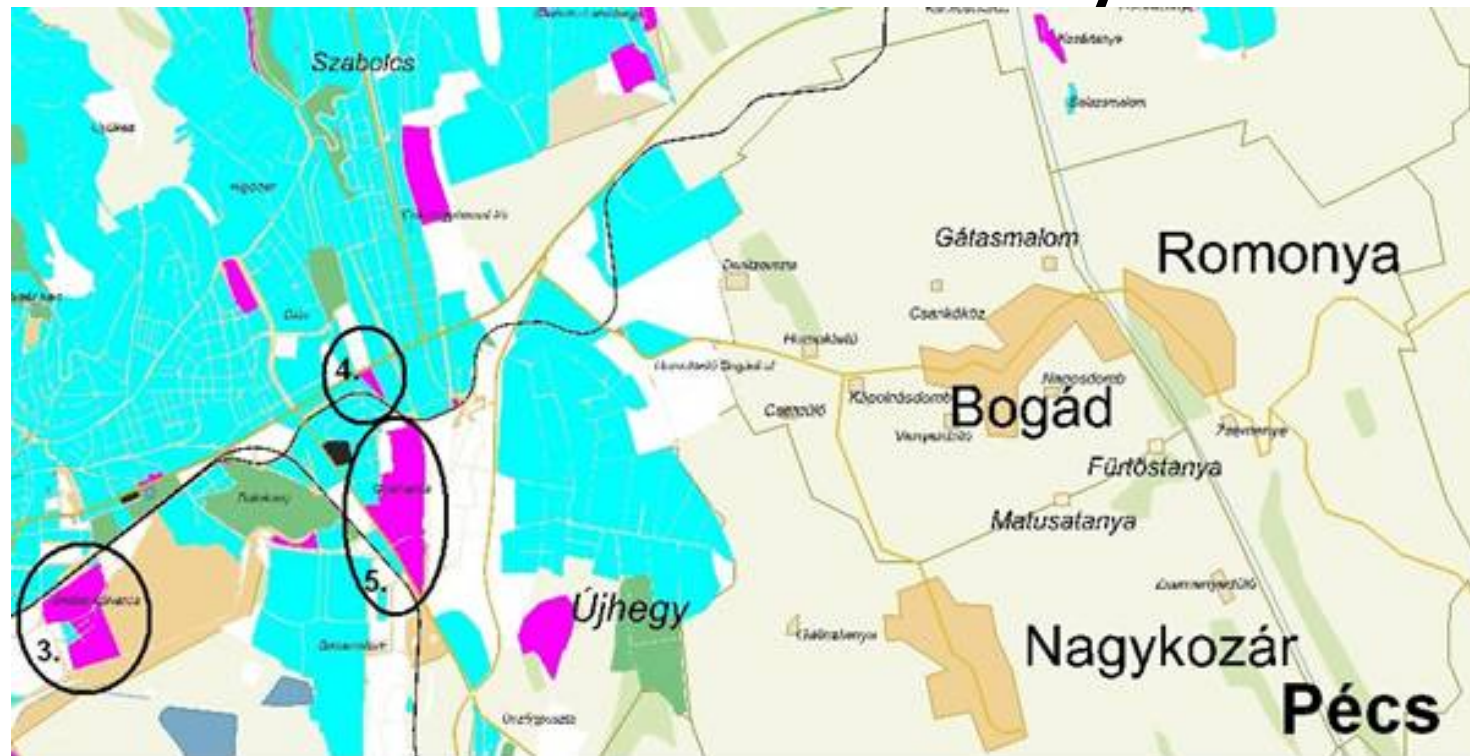
Overview map about segregated areas of the City of Pécs from Antisegregation plan of Pécs,
